We have a bunch of kids, my wife included (photo, left), who are finally winding down their school work and graduating – some from the 6th grade to the local Jr. High, others from Jr. High to the High school about 7 miles down the highway, and finally we have a gal who has been involved with us since she was

5 years old graduating from the high school (praise Him!), along with our two college leaders graduating from the university with degrees in education – God is faithful!!!

MARIBEL – My wife actually graduated unofficially back in February with her entire class (of 2023), then the leaders at her university decided that the official graduation would be in July – then they changed it to <u>June 26</u> at the gym located on campus. About a month ago it got switched to a nicer venue which we are very happy about!

Unfortunately, out of a class of 125 psychology majors, ONLY 25 students will be officially graduating – we are deeply saddened by all the classmates who battled through 4 years with my wife to finally graduate with a decent GPA, but because of one formal test each student has to take after all is said and done, they will not graduate. Also, a handful of her classmates who passed the test will not receive their degrees because the university lost some of their personal documents.

PLEASE pray for all the kids who were denied what was rightfully theirs, that God would make a way and give them favor to finally obtain their degrees . . .

Two months ago the university issued a "dress" code for the graduation, only to change that dress code last week, after so many students had already purchased dresses for the occasion – just yesterday my wife located a dress to meet the code, this after purchasing one last week in San Diego which she cannot use, a beautiful dress. PLEASE pray that all the gals are able to find the correct clothing and the university stop with the shenanigans and allow the kids to enjoy their graduation. PLEASE pray that we all get to enjoy what my wife had committed to the Lord since day one when she started at the university – that God would use her to be a light and bring healing to all those in need of counseling – she has already "ministered" to a child of 6 years old and the Lord has brought healing to this kid, He is faithful . . . we also get to minister to the gals at El Refugio (home for abused girls) twice a week – please pray that the words of encouragement we share will bring healing to these kids who have been deeply hurt . . . God is able. Use us Lord....

CHUCHE & CHAVO – These guys (photo, bottom, middle & right) will be graduating on <u>July 1</u> sans the shenanigans (my wife's university) from the local university U.P.N., which specializes in raising kids to



be educators, and this is exactly what these two have been doing, besides being our college leaders at the ministry – they've been teaching at the local elementary schools in our community and have been doing an amazing job.

Both will be receiving their degrees in education and both want to continue their education (masters) while working at the ministry – please pray that the Lord bless them with teaching jobs in the community so they can continue to shine that light for the Lord to all the kids they work with. We have worked with Chuche since he was 11 years old, Chavo has been with us for 3 years – God is faithful!

YURI – That's her to the right (10 years old) sitting with my wife having lunch – that week the Lord blessed us with the amazing opportunity to build an entire home for her family – sometimes God wants to do the impossible and just hands you the keys to bless people in a mighty way.

Yuri will be graduating from the local high school down the road on <u>July 12</u> and will be our only high school graduate this year. God has given us the blessing of working and ministering to Yuri since

she was 5 years old, and we are so proud that she toughed it out (last year her grades slipped) this year and is graduating with a higher GPA than she



expected. She is also a mentor and an older sister to all the younger gals at the ministry – please pray that if it be God's will, that she will be able to transition to the military with His favor – that has always been her objective, and we have been praying for her.

SAYRA - ELVIS - RAUL These three are so excited to finally leave the local jr. high and will be graduating on <u>July 3</u> - ALL three have raised their GPAs with the "gentle" pushing from yours truly and a lot of encouragement from everyone at the ministry.

Sayra (15) has been with the ministry since she was 10 years old, Elvis joined us over three years ago, and Raul like his sister Yuri has been with us forever . . .

All three take their faith and walk with the Lord seriously, so much so we have seen these three mature into some solid leaders for the ministry – Sayra has been leading and teaching the elementary kids for over a year, while Raul & Elvis display this intensity to be prayer warriors.

PLEASE pray that God would continue to lead and direct them as they make the jump to high school next year, and they would continue to walk with the Lord and be a light – revival at the high school!

PLEASE pray for all these amazing kids, especially Nancy and Cynthia – they have gone "missing" again from the ministry just the last two months, and we don't know where they live or if they have moved again. We have been concerned for their safety since they first joined us – please pray that God would protect them from any abuse, and we would get to see them and invite them out for dinner after their graduation. With all our kids divided up over two schools and morning/evening sessions, there's a possibility we will be attending 3 different graduations that day.

Pray that we survive the day, can celebrate with fireworks later that evening (Lord permitting), and best of all take all our kids out to a very special dinner on the day of their graduation. God is able!
