Luis (23), Chuche (22), and Chavo (21) (L-R) – If you had told me back in 2016 that these three would be our eventual leaders of the ministry, I would have responded with a, "Yeah, when pigs fly!" Get out the NFL pigskins because these guys have been a continual blessing for us the entire year – Luis is gainfully employed at the local government center, taking care of his mom (very ill) and being the sole bread winner, also being our go-to driver when I can't attend along with cleaning the ministry, giving bible studies and leading prayer nights.

That's ditto for Chuche and Chavo, both handling the same responsibilities (less driving) and already enjoying the Lord's favor (both teacher assistants at different elementary schools in Zorrillo) by teaching the same kids that join us at bible studies – they tell me they're always greeted with big hugs from all our kids still in elementary – they both will be graduating from U.P.N. (a university raising solid teachers) this coming spring semester – please pray for God's continued favor for all our leaders.

Rosa (23) & Maritza (6) - Rosa has been our cook for elementary fellowship on Tuesdays and Thursdays for the last few months, and like most moms in Zorrillo is a single mom, the bread winner for her home, currently (praise Him!) living rent free and also providing for her little sister along with making monthly payments on property the Lord has blessed her with - her daughter Maritza has been a part of elementary fellowship since day one and we are hoping to bless each of them with the "1000 Peso Clothes Shopping Spree", and like all of our "kids" who labor for the Lord and the ministry, we would love to bless her with a bonus too. Oyuki (kinda step-sister?) became a part of this family thru her mom. She too is searching for peace which only the Lord can provide. Max (12) – The youngest brother of our Rosa, has been attending Los Elegidos since the days he would show up (at age 9) with his older brother Porfirio (21) who now lives in the U.S. trying to make a go of it in Albany, New York. We currently have a slew of 6th graders that attend the same class and teacher, what a blessing and trial! PLEASE pray for Max, Samantha, Elias One, Angel, Esveidy, and Sinai – that they don't drive that "profe" nuts and all stay on the str8 and narrow – for Max, peace in his home. Some nights he stays with his real dad (photo, left), at other times with Rosa – his mom can't decide where she wants to stay, so every night we ask him where is the drop off – sometimes he doesn't know – please pray that God place His arms around this kid and give him peace. Angel (12) & Evelyn (11) - Sista & bro on the right have been attending since Angel had

the bright idea months ago of starting a fellowship just for elementary kids, Tuesdays and Thursdays, with lots of food (they always arrive hungry) and the Bread of Life. Angel has been attending since age 9 when he snuck in with his older cousins – this is the same Angel & Evelyn who live only a 1/2 a block from their biological mom, but she refuses to care for them since birth.



They are forced to stay with the girlfriend of their deceased great-grandfather, whose life was taken three years ago one morning as his five grandkids looked on. These kids just months ago were threatened by their own mom to be sent to D.I.F. (Mexican Children Services) so she would never have to deal with them again. The day she was to arrive and release them to the police, we made sure they were with us far-far away and "great grandma" knew nothing of their whereabouts.

Mariana (13) & Aby (15) – These two have been a part of our ministry for almost three years, two of the sweetest kids (sisters) you will ever meet, then upon entering high school and Jr. high something changed, so much so that their mom called me one night about two months ago out of desperation (she had already grounded them for 3 months) and asked me to talk to them.

The shenanigans these two were up to, had been doing, had me flabbergasted and in disbelief – I had no words for them, so I pulled out my sidearm, my KJV52 (King James Version) and just started popping off scripture after scripture until they got the message, they were already on the path that leads to destruction. After a firm scolding Aby finally broke down crying and the demeanor of Mariana changed (repentance), then they finally apologized to their mom for wreaking havoc in her life, a christian mom, then we got to pray together, and then I grounded them from the ministry – one month. When they finally came back they again apologized, and it appears they are back on the right path – mom says they're finally behaving and bringing back up their grades – please pray for these

Jovany (17), Elvis (14), & Katy (12) - These three amazing kids (siblings) also joined us about 3 years ago when we had the opportunity to build a shower stall (thanks AZ Team!) for them and do a bit of home improvment on what I can only call the shack they live in. Please pray for both of them as they go thru that "boy crazy" stage - all of our kids know the regulations of our ministry - you CANNOT HAVE a boyfriend or girlfriend until you reach the age of 18 - anyone breaking this rule is immediately dismissed from the ministry or until they break up and wake up to what God has for them... we also tell our kids once they reach 18 we will be happy to assist them in finding a man or woman of God, a perfect helpmate for them. please let us know. These two are really a barrel of laughs and always so upbeat . . . \$59.99 each.





fellowship with us along with Jovany and fam . . . has always been to bible study every night of the week, lives right next door to Esveidy, Chacho, Mariana & Aby, and in spite of that, no one has been able to communicate with him for over a week. He hasn't responded to any of our messages and truth is we are bit worried – please pray that he shows up this Wednesday so we can at least make sure he's okay – he rarely speaks to anyone and is very shy, and yet that is exactly how Chuche was at this age, and now he is our college leader – please pray that God would raise up Josue to be one of our future leaders – God has a plan for him.
