Friday night was a solemn night for me because I had been informed earlier in the morning that my cousin Javier (we grew up together) was in hospice and was at the point of passing away . . . at 1:45pm I asked the Lord to take my cousin home, but to come to him first in a dream and save him, give him a chance to repent and surrender, then take him home. I asked the Lord to take him by 2pm to confirm for me that God had indeed answered my prayers . . . I continued to pray the rest of the day.

Later that night as we finished praying for all the petitions (over 40) from our beloved back home, we prayed that same prayer again, that the Lord would save my cousin in a dream and take him home – we were all in agreement . . . about a half-hour later I received a text that my cousin had passed away – it upset me dearly, and just yesterday I caught myself crying in my wife's arms, several times during the day – we are left with the amazing hope that God indeed answered our prayers and we expect to see my cousin soon as our redemption draws nigh – he is now with his mom who preceded him into eternity with the Lord years ago . . .

True Testimony - "The Lord . . . is patient toward you, not wishing for any to perish but for all to come to repentance."

Many years ago (pre-missionary) when I was working in Oxnard, Ca., I got a frantic call from my mom - my "Tia Jenny" (aunt) had suffered a horrific aneurysm and was given by the attending physicians just a day or two to live - she was Javier's mom. As I sat there eating my lunch just after hanging up from my mom I began to cry - my tia Jenny had been literally my second mom, the team cook for her husband's youth soccer team all those years we played together since the 3rd grade - over the years before she passed I would always see her in my hometown (Carpinteria) and the Lord would ALWAYS tweak my spirit, "Go talk to your aunt about Me." This happened on several occasions and like a coward I did not answer the Lord's call.

As I sat there in my car drowning in conviction and tears I pleaded with the Lord - "God, PLEASE don't let my aunt die! I promise I will go see her tomorrow and pray for her, I promise!" That next day came, I tried to get some time off and my employer said no - I called my mom and asked how my aunt was doing, she said my aunt probably would not make it till tomorrow.... I prayed the whole day asking the Lord to please keep my aunt alive until I had the chance to be at her side and pray with her . . .

The next day came and God blessed me with a half-day off . . . at 12pm I left my job and raced to Santa Barbara Cottage Hospital before it was too late. I ran upstairs to see my aunt on the 2nd floor and ran into my dad with his twin brother who were seated down the hallway, than I ran to her room

and saw my cousin standing over his mom - my aunt seemed to be (I was told by my cousin she couldn't hear) flailing her arms at something in the air, and their was this look of terror on her face although her eyes were closed. I could see my cousin felt helpless, and so I asked to pray for her - my cousin said yes, and as soon as I took my aunt's hand in mine I began to cry, and cry and cry, because this was something the Lord had asked me to do with my aunt years ago - I finally began to pray with my aunt and told her that if she could hear me (my cousin again said she couldn't hear) to just please repeat this prayer with me, "Lord Jesus, please forgive me of my sins - I want to receive you right now as my Lord and Saviour - I ask for your forgiveness Lord, please save me today, and protect me with your angels."

Immediately my aunt stopped flailing her arms and her body, a calm look came over her face and the same aunt who looked terrified was now at peace laying there in her hospital bed – my cousin was sobbing, I was crying because I thought I had just witnessed a miracle, and I asked the Lord "Please Lord, give me a sign that my aunt heard me Lord, please." At that very moment my aunt slowly squeezed my hand three times, as if to say she had heard me and my prayers had been answered. That day I left my aunt's side KNOWING that God had indeed saved my aunt, that I would see her again when I get to heaven . . . the next morning my aunt passed away.

The joy of the Lord is our salvation . . . one day very soon I will get to see my aunt and Javier, but this time in their glorified bodies looking young and fit as ever!

I am forever blessed to know that one day we will have a grand family reunion, and it will be for eternity! God is good, all the time!
