drinks she has extended us on credit over all these years (8) - she started crying and asked me if we really had to move - I shared with her that God was directing our steps, but promised that we would

ALWAYS come back and raid her store and run up a bill and pay her on the spot. We were her best customer!

We have so many memories of the beautiful and wonderful things the Lord has done through the ministry center – we will cherish everyone who has walked through those doors to hear about the

Lord, to serve with us from afar, and continue to pray for them. Sometimes change hurts - all God asks of us is to trust Him and not lean on our own understanding, to follow the path He has laid out for us . . .

(PLEASE pray for our new location, that the owner will complete the tasks and repair everything he said he would – this place needs a lot of TLC, that God gives us favor and He would bring in a new harvest, that He be glorified in this place. We don't want it any other way.)
