

Evelyn (11) and Sayra (14, photo-right) want to THANK YOU for blessing us with a ton of red chile-beef tamales, dozens of homemade chocolate-chip cookies provided by our brother Lee who owns a bakery shop nearby, and some amazing "buñuelos" (fried flour tortillas covered with cinnamon sugar) that we enjoyed throughout the night with our preferred drink Peñafiel (sparkling lemonade, orange, strawberry). We had so much food we were able to send kids home with tamales and buñuelos!

during the encouragement session. She was so glad to be back in the mix with the kids after enduring a very lengthy last semester of school – thank you for keeping her in your prayers.



fellowship, great Word, and a spirit of unity as we gave thanks and praise for the birth of our Lord and Saviour . . .



Finally, on the way home that evening the last kid we dropped off was our kid (right) Nicoll - that's her three years ago at her last Christ-Mas celebration with us, a few months later she stopped coming to the ministry and only recently returned last month . . . she is now 14 and after speaking to her briefly, my wife and I realized this kid has had to become the adult of her family - that's too much to ask of any teen girl . . . when we got to see where she lived, we were heartbroken and promised to return the next day with blankets.

The next evening it was raining (photo below) and the only thing covering her



roof was the plastic tarp you see in the photo – it was only by chance I was able to take these photos – our van got stuck in the mud and we had to call her uncle to rescue us – I praise God that Nicoll and mom decided to stay with family that night because it was freezing in the



small shack they call home. We also gave thanks to God because a well-known Christian group that builds homes for families in the area had already laid a foundation in front of the small structure and will start building tomorrow! Their new home should be finished in seven days, and as I spoke to the mom's boyfriend I asked if there was any way we could assist - they are currently in need of 150 cinder blocks to finish their septic tank (about \$175) so by the time the new home is finished, they will have access to an outside restroom. If there is anyone who would like to help our kid Nicoll, please let us know.

To the right is the bed Nicoll, mom, and her younger brother have been sharing now for over a month – she had

mentioned she had a place to sleep, what she didn't mention it was the same bed.

When their new home is ready they will need a decent (smaller) fridge, more bedding, etc. If the Lord lays on your heart anything you would like to donate, please let us know! Think house-warming party!

Thanks again for all the amazing blessings you shared with our kids – we still have much clothes shopping to do after the 1st with all YOUR kids of El Zorrillo!
